#### **Our Mission**







# **Food Security**

<u>63,852</u> people fed

581,464 meals provided

- 92% report they are eating more nutritious food
- 94% report they worry less about food insecurity

# Housing Stability

2,791 households avoided eviction/foreclosure <u>\$7.8M</u> paid towards housing expenses <u>269</u> adults provided with emergency shelter <u>11,764</u> shelter bed nights made possible <u>140</u> adults transitioned to a permanent home or diverted from shelter

- 80% report they worry less about housing expenses
- 86% feel confident in their ability to improve their financial situation

### Health & Well-being

310 families provided with prenatal care and early childhood development support 90% babies born within healthy birthweights 174 older adults received in-home support services

- 89% report their quality of life has improved
- 95% feel a stronger connection to their community
- 83% of older adult respondents report increased independence and ability to age in place



#### Economic Empowerment

<u>216</u> received Financial Success Center services
<u>37</u> points: average credit score increase
<u>56%</u> households increased their net income
<u>90%</u> retained employment for at least 90-days

- 82% feel more prepared to obtain and maintain employment
- 82% feel more confident in their ability to achieve their financial goals
